

42[54,66] sts rem. Work 5[7,7] rows straight.

Shape sleeves

Cast on 4 sts at beg of next 2 rows. 50[62,74] sts. Work straight until sleeve meas 6[8,10] cm ending with WS facing for next row.

Shape back neck

Next row—P20[25,29], turn and complete this side first.

Dec 1 st at neck edge on next 5 rows. 15[20,24] sts rem. Purl 1 row. Cast off.

With WS facing slip centre 10[12,16] sts onto a spare needle, rejoin yarn to neck edge of rem 20[25,29] sts and purl to end. Dec 1 st at neck edge on next 5 rows. 15[20,24] sts rem. Purl 1 row. Cast off.

LEFT FRONT

With 3 mm needles and C cast on 26[32,38] sts.

Work as for Back from ★ to ★.

Change to 3¾ mm needles and patt thus:

Note: When changing colour in row, twist yarns together on wrong side of work to avoid making a hole.

Row 1—(Side Edge), Using MS knit to last 3 sts, using C K3.

Row 2—Using C K1, ML into each of next 2 sts, using MS purl to end.

★★ Rep the last 2 rows once more. Keeping border at front edge correct dec 1 st at side edge of next and every foll 4th[8th,12th] row until 23[29,35] sts rem. Work 5[7,7] rows straight (work 1 row more here for Right Front).

Shape sleeve

Cast on 4 sts at beg of next row. 27[33,39] sts. Work straight until front is 9[11,13] rows shorter than back to shoulder (work 1 row more here for Right Front), thus ending at front edge.

Shape neck

Next row—Work 8[9,10] sts, slip these sts onto a safety pin, work to end.

Dec 1 st at neck edge on next 3 rows, then foll 1[1,2] alt rows. 15[20,24] sts rem. Work 3[5,5] rows straight (work 1 row less here for Right Front) thus ending with a WS row. Cast off.

RIGHT FRONT

With 3 mm needles and C cast on 26[32,38] sts.

Work as for Back from ★ to ★.

Change to 3¾ mm needles and MS and patt thus:

Row 1—(Front Edge), Knit.

Row 2—Purl to last 3 sts, K3.

Complete as for Left Front from ★★ to end reversing shapings as indicated.

BELT

With 3¾ mm needles and MS cast on 7[8,9] sts and work 30[40,45] cm in garter st (every row knit). Cast off.

MAKE UP

Press lightly following instructions on ball band. Join shoulder seams.

Neck Edging

With 3 mm needles and C and RS facing, knit across sts at right front neck, **knit up** 8[10,12] sts up right front slope, 5 sts down right back neck, knit across sts at back neck, **knit up** 5 sts up left back neck, 8[10,12] sts down left front slope and knit across sts at left front neck. 52[60,70] sts.

★★★ **Next row**—K1, ML into each st to last st, K1.

Next row—Knit.

Next row—K1, ML into each st to last st, K1.

Cast off ★★★.

Sleeve Edging

With 3 mm needles and C and RS facing, **knit up** 36[46,54] sts evenly along side edge of sleeve. Work as for Neck Edging from ★★★ to ★★★.

Join side and underarm seams. Sew 3[4,4] press studs evenly spaced along front edge. Thread buckle onto centre of belt and sew press studs onto each end. Fasten at back.

Trousers

LEGS (Make 2)

With 3 mm needles and C cast on 46[60,72] sts.

Work as for Back of Jacket from ★ to ★.

Change to 3¾ mm needles and MS and work in stocking st, starting knit, until leg meas 5[7,10] cm ending with RS facing for next row.

Shape top

Cast off 1[2,3] sts at beg of next 2 rows. Dec 1 st at each end of next 2[4,4] rows. 40[48,58] sts rem. Work straight until body meas 8[10,13] cm from cast off sts ending with RS facing for next row and decreasing 1 st at centre of last row. 39[47,57] sts rem.

Change to 3 mm needles.

Rib row 1—K1, *P1, K1; rep from * to end.

Rib row 2—P1, *K1, P1; rep from * to end.

Rep the last 2 rows twice more. Cast off in rib.

MAKE UP

Press lightly following instructions on ball band. Join front, back and inside leg seams. Thread shirring elastic through rib at waist if required.

Hat

With 3 mm needles and C cast on 81[99,117] sts. Work as for Back of Jacket from ★ to ★.

Change to 3¾ mm needles and MS and work in stocking st, starting knit, until hat meas 12[15,18] cm ending with RS facing for next row.

Shape top

Row 1—*K7[9,11], K2tog; rep from * to end. 72[90,108] sts rem.

Work 7 rows straight.

Row 9—*K6[8,10], K2tog; rep from * to end. 63[81,99] sts rem.

Work 7 rows straight.

Row 17—*K5[7,9], K2tog; rep from * to end. 54[72,90] sts rem.

Cont to dec 9 sts in this way on every foll 8th row until 18 sts rem.

Work 7 rows straight.

Next row—*K2tog; rep from * to end.

Break yarn, thread through rem 9 sts, draw up firmly and fasten off.

MAKE UP

Press lightly following instructions on ball band. Join back seam. With C make a pom-pom and attach firmly to end of Hat.

11.

Bikini, beach mat and bag

Size

To fit Teddy Bear height approximately 38[48,58] cm (15[19,23] in). Chest 31[33[41/43,51/53] cm (12/13[16/17,20/21] in).

Materials

Bikini: Patons Beehive Soft Blend 4 Ply (50 gram), 15[25,35]g Main Shade, oddments in Contrast.

Pair 3 mm (USA 3) needles.

Mat and Bag: Patons Beehive Soft Blend DK (50 gram), 1[2,2] balls Main Shade, 1[1,2] balls Contrast.

Pair 3¾ mm (USA 5) needles.

Tension

4 Ply: On 3 mm needles, 26 sts and 42 rows to 10 cm (moss st).

DK: On 3¾ mm needles, 24 sts and 32 rows to 10 cm (stocking st).

For notes and abbreviations, see first page of text.

Bikini

PANTS (Make 2 pieces)

With 3 mm needles and MS cast on 5[7,9] sts.

Row 1—(RS), K1, *P1, K1; rep from * to end. This row forms moss st. Rep this row 3 times more. Keeping moss st correct inc 1 st at each end of next and every foll 4th row 4[5,6] times in all. 13[17,21] sts. Inc 1 st at each end of next 3[5,7] rows. Cast on 5 sts at beg of next

Nautical Sweater Knitting pattern

2 rows then 5[5,6] sts at beg of foll 2 rows. 39[47,57] sts.

Work 2 rows straight, then work 2 rows in C and 2 rows in MS. Rep the last 4 rows 1[1,2] times more. With MS cast off.

TOP (Make 2 pieces)

With 3 mm needles and MS cast on 3[5,7] sts and work 6 rows in moss st as for Pants. Keeping moss st correct throughout inc 1 st at each end of next and every foll 8th row until there are 9[11,13] sts. Work straight until piece meas 17[20,23] cm. Inc 1 st at each end of next 2 rows. 13[15,17] sts. Work 2 rows in C and 2 rows in MS. Rep the last 4 rows 4[5,6] times more.

Decrease row—With C K1, *K2tog; rep from * to end.

Cast off rem 7[8,9] sts.

TIES (Make 3)

With 3 mm needles and C cast on 3[4,5] sts and work 10[11,12] cm in stocking st. Cast off.

MAKE UP

Press lightly following instructions on ball band.

Join side seams and cast on edges of Pants. Join cast off edges of Top. Knot one Tie at each side seam of Pants and one at centre of Top as illustrated.

Beach Mat

With 3³/₄ mm needles and MS cast on 60[78,96] sts and working in garter st (every row knit), work 2 rows in MS and 2 rows in C throughout until piece meas approximately 45[50,55] cm ending with 2 rows in MS. Cast off.

MAKE UP

Press lightly following instructions on ball band.

Fringe

*Cut 4 lengths of MS each 8 cm long. Fold these in half and pull centre through first st at cast on edge, bring ends through centre of loop and pull to tighten knot (1 tassel made). Rep from * along cast on and cast off edges, working 1 tassel into every alternate st. Trim ends of tassels.

Bag (Make 2 pieces)

With 3³/₄ mm needles and MS cast on 16[24,32] sts and work 9[14,18] cm in garter st (every row knit).

Eyelet row—K1, *yfwd, K2tog, K2; rep from * to last 3 sts, yfwd, K2tog, K1.

Work 7[9,11] rows straight.

Change to C and work 2 more rows. Cast off.

MAKE UP

Press lightly following instructions on ball band.

Join 3 sides of bag, leaving cast off edge open. Using C make a twisted cord 60 cm long and thread through eyelet holes.

12. Nautical sweater and shorts

Size

To fit Teddy Bear height approximately 38[48,58] cm (15[19,23] in). Chest 31/33[41/43,51/53] cm (12/13[16/17,20/21] in).

Materials

Patons Beehive Soft Blend DK (50 gram), 1[2,2] balls Main Shade, 1[1,1] ball Contrast. Oddment of yarn for Anchor motif.

Pair each 3 mm (USA 3) and 3³/₄ mm (USA 5) needles. Shirring elastic for shorts if required.

Tension

On 3³/₄ mm needles, 22 sts and 38 rows to 10 cm (moss st).

On 3³/₄ mm needles, 24 sts and 32 rows to 10 cm (stocking st).

For notes and abbreviations, see first page of text.

Sweater

BACK AND FRONT ALIKE

With 3³/₄ mm needles and MS cast on 37[49,59] sts.

Row 1—(RS), K1, *P1, K1; rep from * to end.

This row forms moss st. Rep this row 7 times more. Cont in moss st working in stripes of 8 rows in C and 8 rows in MS until piece meas approximately 15[21,25] cm ending with 8 rows in MS or C. Cast off in pattern.

SLEEVES

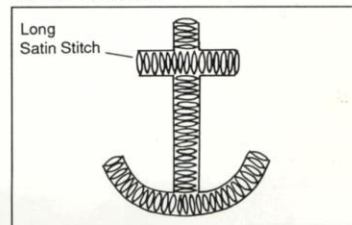
With 3³/₄ mm needles and MS cast on 35[45,53] sts and work 2[2,4] rows in moss st. Change to C and continuing in moss st work 5[9,11] rows. Cast off in pattern.

POCKET

With 3³/₄ mm needles and MS cast on 10[11,12] sts and work 14[16,18] rows in stocking st, starting knit. Change to C and work 3 rows in garter st (every row knit). Cast off knitways.

MAKE UP

Press lightly following instructions on ball band. Join shoulder seams leaving 13[15,17] cm open at centre for neck. Place centre of cast off edge of sleeves to shoulder seams and sew Sleeves in position to Back and Front. Join side and sleeve seams. Using oddment of yarn embroider anchor onto pocket (see diagram) and sew pocket onto front as illustrated.



Shorts (Make 2 pieces)

With 3³/₄ mm needles and MS cast on 45[57,69] sts and work 3 rows in garter st (first row is wrong side). Work 4[6,8] rows in stocking st, starting knit.

Shape top

Cast off 1[2,3] sts at beg of next 2 rows. Dec 1 st at each end of next 2[2,3] rows. 39[49,57] sts rem. Work straight until body meas 8[10,13] cm measured straight from cast off sts, ending with RS facing for next row.

Change to 3 mm needles.

Rib row 1—K1, *P1, K1; rep from * to end.

Rib row 2—P1, *K1, P1; rep from * to end.

Rep the last 2 rows 1[2,2] times more. Cast off in rib.

MAKE UP

Press lightly following instructions on ball band.

Join front, back and inside leg seams. Thread shirring elastic through ribbing at waist if required.
